## Brief Description of PDaaS Services

### Foundations for Teachers Workshop (each site)

- 1 Workshop per school **site** to support community building and application, 3.5 hours by Zoom
- Suitable for mixed-level & mixed-content application
- Emphasis on appropriate use for student engagement and learning (i.e., pedagogy)

### Foundations for Leadership Workshop (each cluster)

- 1 Workshop per school **cluster** to support cross-sharing, 4 hours by Zoom (in 1 or 2 sessions)
- Participants: principals, vice principals, deans of students, department heads, etc.
- Emphasis on instructional leadership, strategic planning, and appropriate use

### Monthly Micro-Sprints (each cluster)

- Teacher workshops per school **cluster**, 45 minutes per session by Zoom
- Deeper dive into specific topics, teacher workflows, and instructional application

### Monthly AI-PLC Coaching (each site)

- 3–7 participants per school **site**, 45 minutes per session by Zoom
- Develop local experts and role models for in-house support and encouragement

### Drop-in Office Hours

- Immediate support for implementation, trouble-shooting, and alignment with learning goals
- 4 hours per week, customized schedule, by Zoom

### Quarterly Leadership Studios (each cluster)

- Leadership workshops per school **cluster**, 1.5 hours by Zoom
- Interactive work sessions based on local interests and leadership roles
- Guidance and support for managing and leading appropriate school deployment

### Survey, Needs, & Goals

- Status check on staff understanding, usage, and adoption
- Leadership discussions of needs, expectations, and desired outcomes

### Policy Review & Fine-Tuning

- Review of existing policies for students and staff, identifying strengths and gaps
- Policy recommendations for safe and appropriate AI implementation

### Community Awareness Support

- Templates and sample parent letters, newsletter articles
- Support for developing awareness campaign, garnering support, mitigating resistance
- Community presentation (by Zoom, in-person option)
